Hi Everyone,

As always, because you are a member of the Side Hill Cronchers, we try to make your TMA/Membership purchase as simple as possible. If you fill out the enclosed form (one for each machine) and mail it to us, along with your check and required paperwork, we will mail back your TMA/Membership sticker and membership to you. We do have TMA/Membership outlets in Ludlow at Ludlow NAPA, Ludlow Insurance, Bensons Chevrolet and the Ludlow Country Store, however, the mail-in membership will take the pressure off of them and hopefully prevent a last minute rush for you so you won't have to wait in line.

There is once again a substantial savings in the cost of all TMA memberships if they are purchased prior to December 15th. This is an absolute deadline. The costs are outlined in the attached application form. In addition, all memberships received before December 15th will be entered into a raffle at VAST for a 2016 Polaris 800 Indy® SP snowmobile.

The TMA rates are also determined by where your machine is registered. If it is registered in Vermont you will qualify for the In State prices. If the machine is registered in another state you will have to pay the Out of State price.

LIMITED LIABILITY STATEMENT
(Must be signed)

As a member of a snowmobile club I, the undersigned, owner of the snowmobile described above, declare that I am liable for the use of a trail in conformance with the snowmobile laws and rules of the State of Vermont. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, I declare that I am well aware of the risks related to the presence of tree branches, stones and soil on the trail as well as the risks related to the maintenance and signing of a trail. I consequently declare that I deny my own recourse to any damage, be it of any kind that could happen to me in the use of a trail. I also pledge that I will inform any person to whom I would lend or rent the snowmobile that I own, of the risks above mentioned and will advise them that the association, the club or the owner of the trail do not assume any responsibility for the damages they could undergo while using the trail.

As of September 1, 2003, every individual operating a snowmobile in Vermont is required to have personal liability insurance. The minimum required coverage is \$25,000 for one injury or \$50,000 for two or more injuries or deaths with a minimum of \$10,000 property damage. The fine for operating without the insurance is \$601.00 plus court costs.

Note: Any person born after July 1st, 1983 must pass a VAST certified Snowmobile Safety Course and carry a certificate of completion with them at all times when snowmobiling on VAST trails.

Note: Be sure to fill out the application and liability forms in total.

Note: To qualify for the **Family TMA** discount all snowmobiles must be registered in the same name at the same address and be submitted before December 15th.

Note: To qualify for an in-state TMA the snowmobile must be registered in VT you do not need to own land.

Note: Please submit a copy of a valid State snowmobile registration certificate for each application.

Note: Please submit the correct amount due.

Note: The Limited Liability Statement must be signed if you choose to join by mail.

Note: A separate application is required for each snowmobile. Please make copies.

Note: To get early bird pricing, the application must be post-marked before December 15th.
